MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)

Adds an extra layer of verification to ensure users are who they say they are.

RPO (Recovery Point Objective)	The maximum acceptable amount of data loss measured in time.	- Defines how much data you can afford to lose. - Influences backup frequency and technology. - Critical for data integrity and compliance.
RTO vs. RPO (The Balance)	RTO is about time. RPO is about data. Both are critical.	- Balance speed of recovery with data protection needs. - Align with business priorities and risk tolerance. - The right balance delivers resilience.

EXAMPLE SCENARIO



A financial services firm defines the following:

RTO: 2 hours
(Systems must be back online within 2 hours)

RPO: 15 minutes
(No more than 15 minutes of data loss is acceptable)

Result: Minimal disruption, protected data, and confident customers.

Record results, identify gaps, and take action to improve your recovery readiness.
